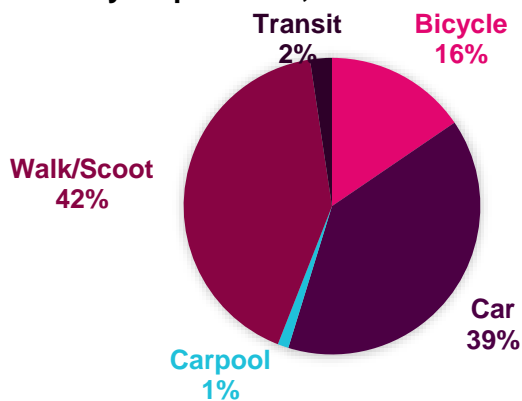

An on-line school travel survey was distributed to parents between November 5 - 23, 2018. From Frank Hobbs, 85 families completed the survey representing approximately 30% of the school population. The initial results of the survey found...

Of the survey respondents, Frank Hobbs students usually get to school by...



60% use active transportation to travel to school

40% of students are driven to school

Frank Hobbs has the potential for even more active travel with 89% of parents preferring that their eldest child use active transportation (walk, bike or bus) to the school.

Why do Frank Hobbs students usually get driven to school?

- Convenience/Time pressures
- Traffic safety concerns

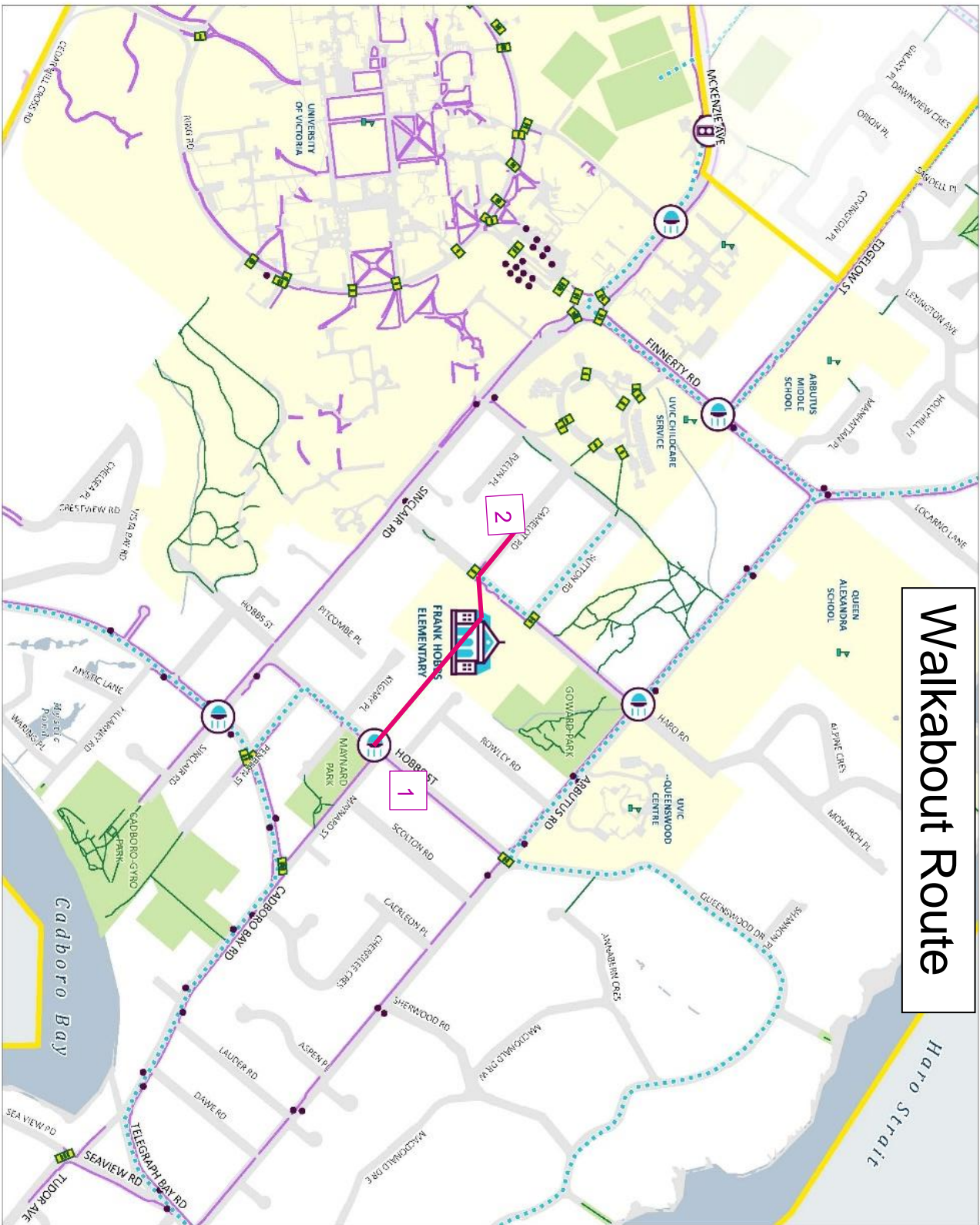
Frank Hobbs parents say they would encourage their child to walk or bike to school if:

- Continuous sidewalks/trails and bike facilities
- Additional marked pedestrian and cycling crossings
- Lower vehicle traffic volumes/speeds

Locations of concern (location and description)

- **Pathway from Maynard Park** –Maintenance of path, lighting; crossing at Hobbs and Maynard – sightlines, vehicle speed
- **Camelot Rd** – Vehicle drop-offs and u-turns, no sidewalk, concern about crosswalk at Haro
- **Arbutus Rd and Haro** – Not stopping at crosswalk, vehicle volume and speed
